Before attempting to connect or operate this product, please read the instructions completely.

Precautions

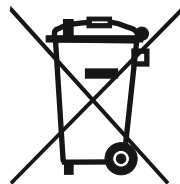
- Pay utmost attention if you install the DVD player into the driver's compartment.
- Use only in cars with a 12 Volt negative ground.
- Before wiring, disconnect the cable from the negative battery terminal to avoid short circuits or electrical shocks. Make the correct connections.
- Do not damage pipe or wiring when drilling holes.
- Arrange the wiring so it is not crimped or pinched by a sharp metal edge.
- Do not install the DVD player in locations which might hinder vehicle operations and do not install in locations with any moisture. Use the installation materials provided with the DVD player.
- Do not use bolts or nuts in the brake, airbags or other safety relevant systems to make ground connections.
- Attention! This DVD player is developed for motor vehicle use only.
- **WARNING: DO NOT WATCH MOVIES WHILE DRIVING TO AVOID DANGER!**

Warranty

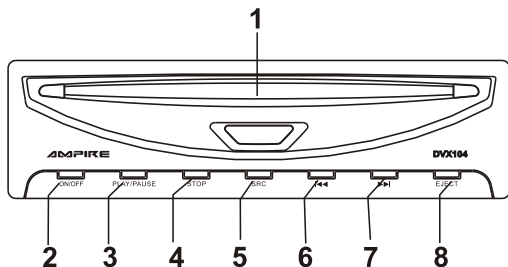

- The packing can be recycled. Dispose the packing in a collecting system planned for it.

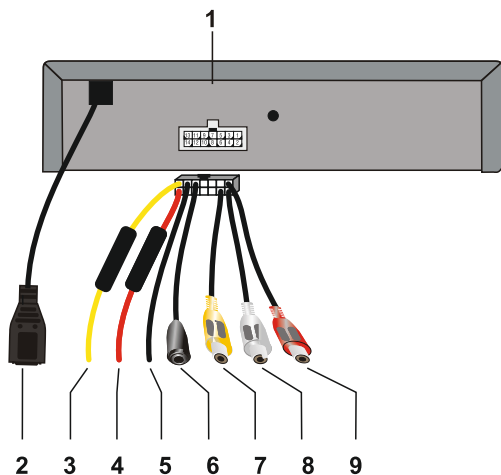


Front Panel

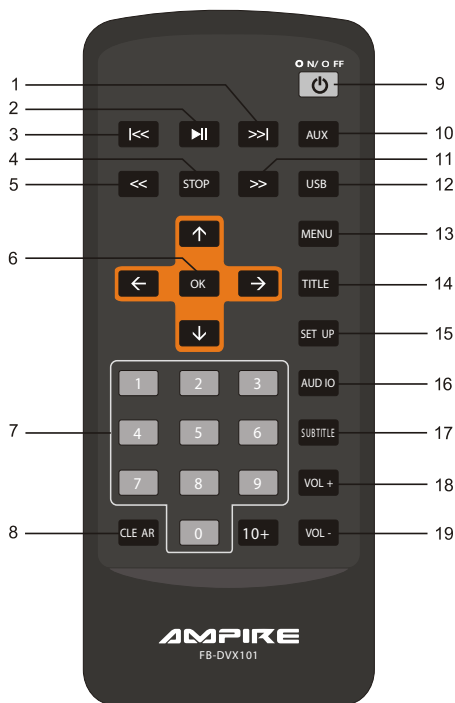
- 1) Main Connector

Insert Batteries into Remote

- Open the battery compartment.
- Insert a "2025" battery. Make sure of right polarity.
- Close the battery compartment.
- While operating remote control, please point it to the front panel of the DVX104 or IR sensor..

- 1) Next
- 2) Play / Pause
- 3) Previous
- 4) Stop & Return
- 5) Backward
- 6) OK
- 7) Number Buttons: To enter the numbers directly
- 8) Clear: Push to clear the entered numbers
- 9) Power On / Off

- 12) USB: Press 1x = USB, press again = back to DVD.
- 13) Menu / PCB: Push to display the option menu while playing the DVD
- 14) Title: Push title to display the title menu.

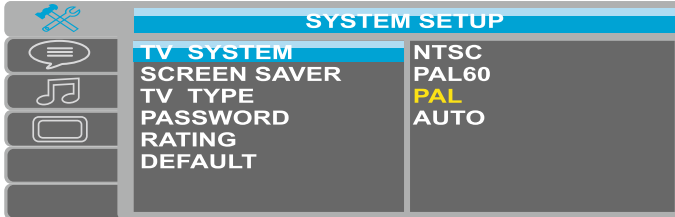


Settings

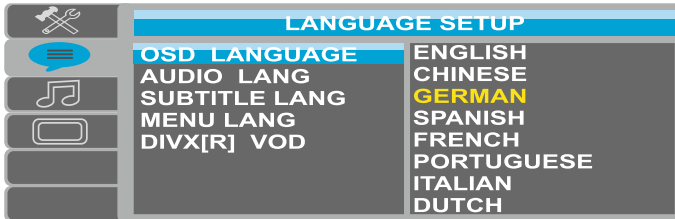

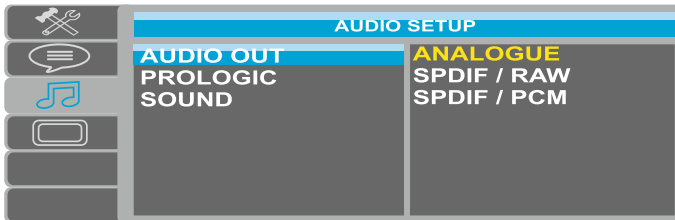

CD & DVD Playback

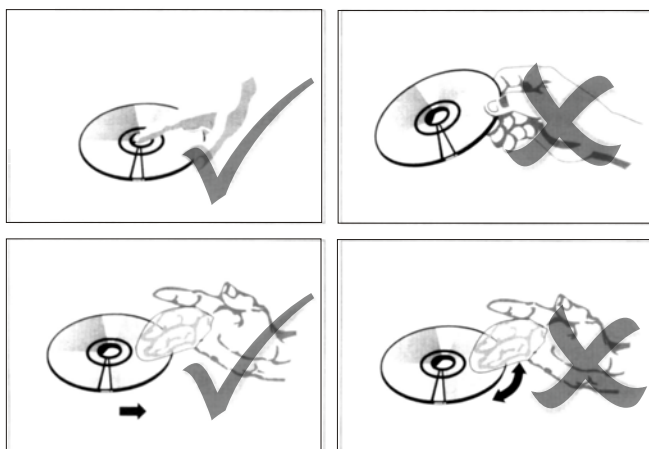
Insert a disc into the loader and follow the information on the screen. Use the remote like described on page 10 or the keys of the DVX104 (for operating the main functions) like described on Page 9. Push the EJECT button to remove the disc.

USB Playback

Insert your USB drive into the USB connector of the player. The DVX104 will switch to USB automatically and shows the USB menu. Select the right file type (Music, Video, Photo) and start the playback by pushing the OK button of your remote. To return to the disc playback please push the USB button of your remote or the SRC button of the DVX104's front panel.

How to Deal with Disc

- Do not touch the unlabeled side of the disc.
- When there are stains on face of disc wipe gently with a wet cloth and then with a dry one.
- When a disc is brought in from a cold environment to a hot one, condensation can form on the face of the disc. Wipe down with a soft, smooth, dry cloth before using.
- Do not write on the unlabeled side of the disc.
- Do not use chemical solutions to clean the disc's.
- Do not stick labels or glue-based notes on the disc.
- Do not use disc's with glue residue or damaged labels.
- Do not use anti-scratching materials or covers, that were not designed for this machine.
- Do not put or store the disc directly under the sunlight, in moist or dusty environments or beside heating elements.
